GRAB A JAB!

Aged 16+ and not yet had your COVID-19 vaccine? Still waiting to have your second dose or booster? Pop down to one of our 'grab a jab' clinics and get vaccinated. No appointment is needed, and you don't need to be registered with a GP.

The COVID-19 vaccination offers you the best protection from the virus. Remember, it is important that you get both doses of the vaccine.

Need help getting to a clinic? Healthwatch Knowsley can support you with **FREE** transport to and from your clinic. Call **0151 449 3954** (lines are open Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm) and they will talk you through your options to get to your appointment or a drop in clinic close by to you.

ALREADY HAD YOUR FIRST JAB?

If you've had your first jab, you can attend the clinic to get your second jab provided there has been at least eight weeks since your first dose. The walk-in clinics stock the Pfizer and AstraZeneca vaccines.

LOOKING TO GET YOUR BOOSTER JAB?

If you are eligible for your booster vaccination, and there has been at least 6 months since your second dose, you will be able to get your jab at the vaccination clinic.

NOT AVAILABLE WHEN THE BUS IS IN YOUR AREA?

Don't worry. You can still book a COVID-19 vaccination appointment if you prefer. Visit www.nhs.uk/coronavirus, call 119 or contact your GP.

KEEPING GETTING TESTED

Once you've had your vaccine it is important you still regularly test for COVID-19. The vaccine protects you from the virus, but you might still be able to carry it and pass it on.
